The Northwest Hills Council of Governments (NHCOC) is developing a Regional Transportation Plan to guide future transportation decisions in the region. The Plan will consider all means of travel including automobile, transit (including rail), walking, and bicycle. The Plan will develop a vision for transportation priorities and recommend improvements throughout the region to help realize the vision. Development of this Plan will also assist in securing funding for improvements.
