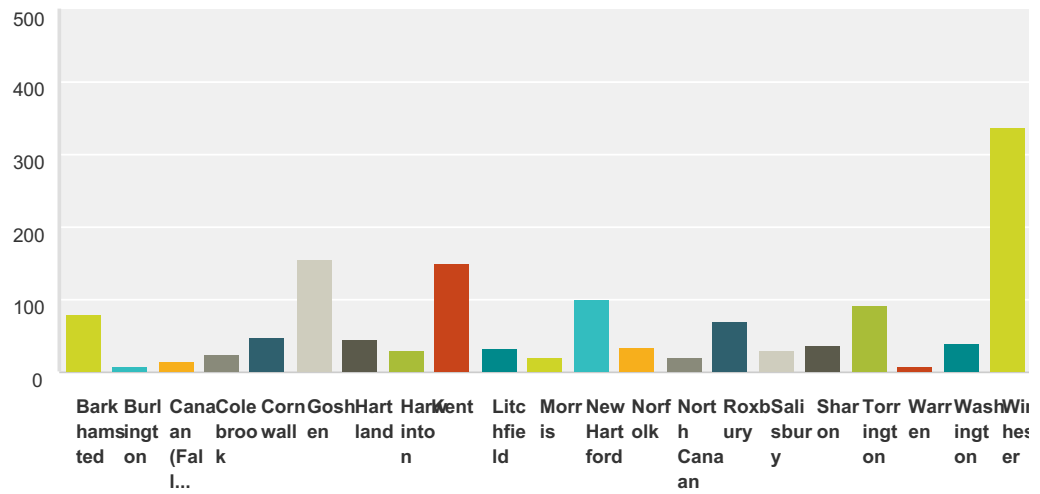


Q1 Which NHCOC region town do you currently live in?

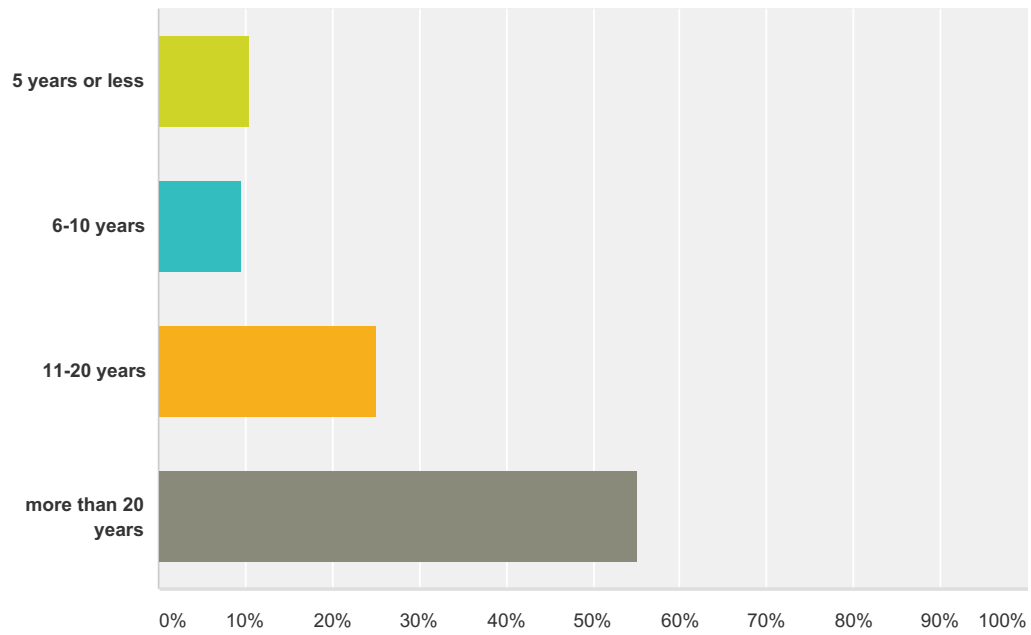

Q2 How long have you lived in the 21-town NHCOG region?

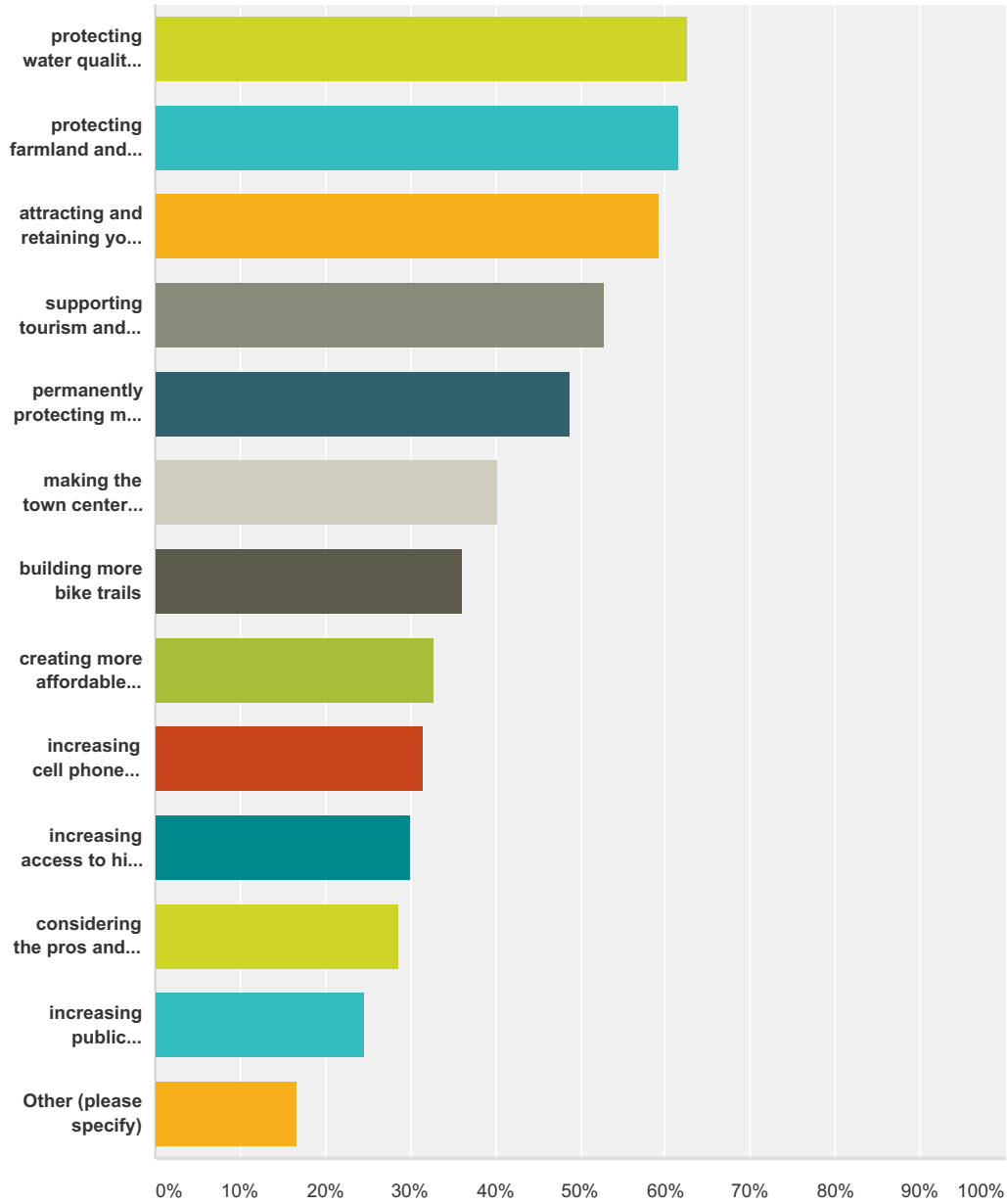

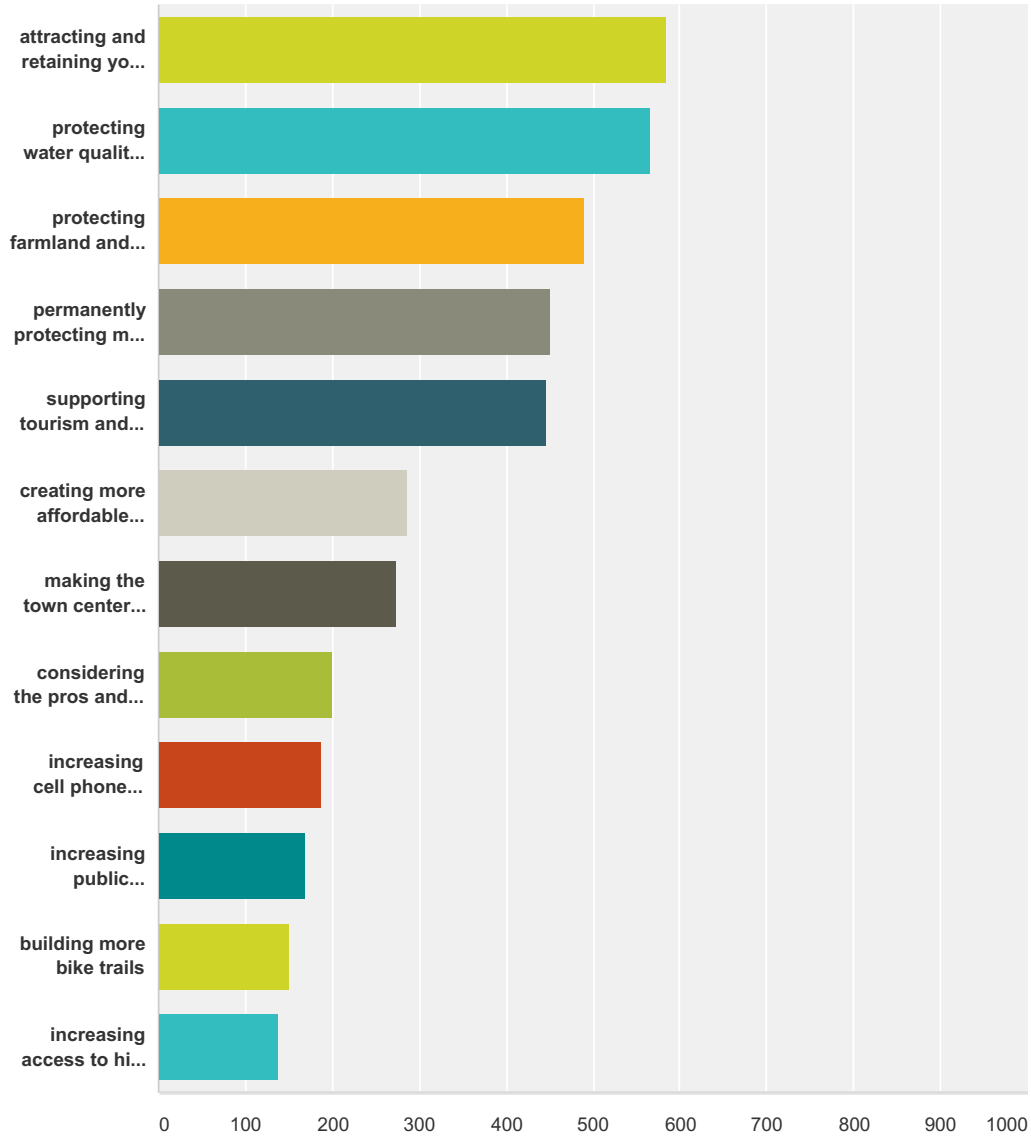

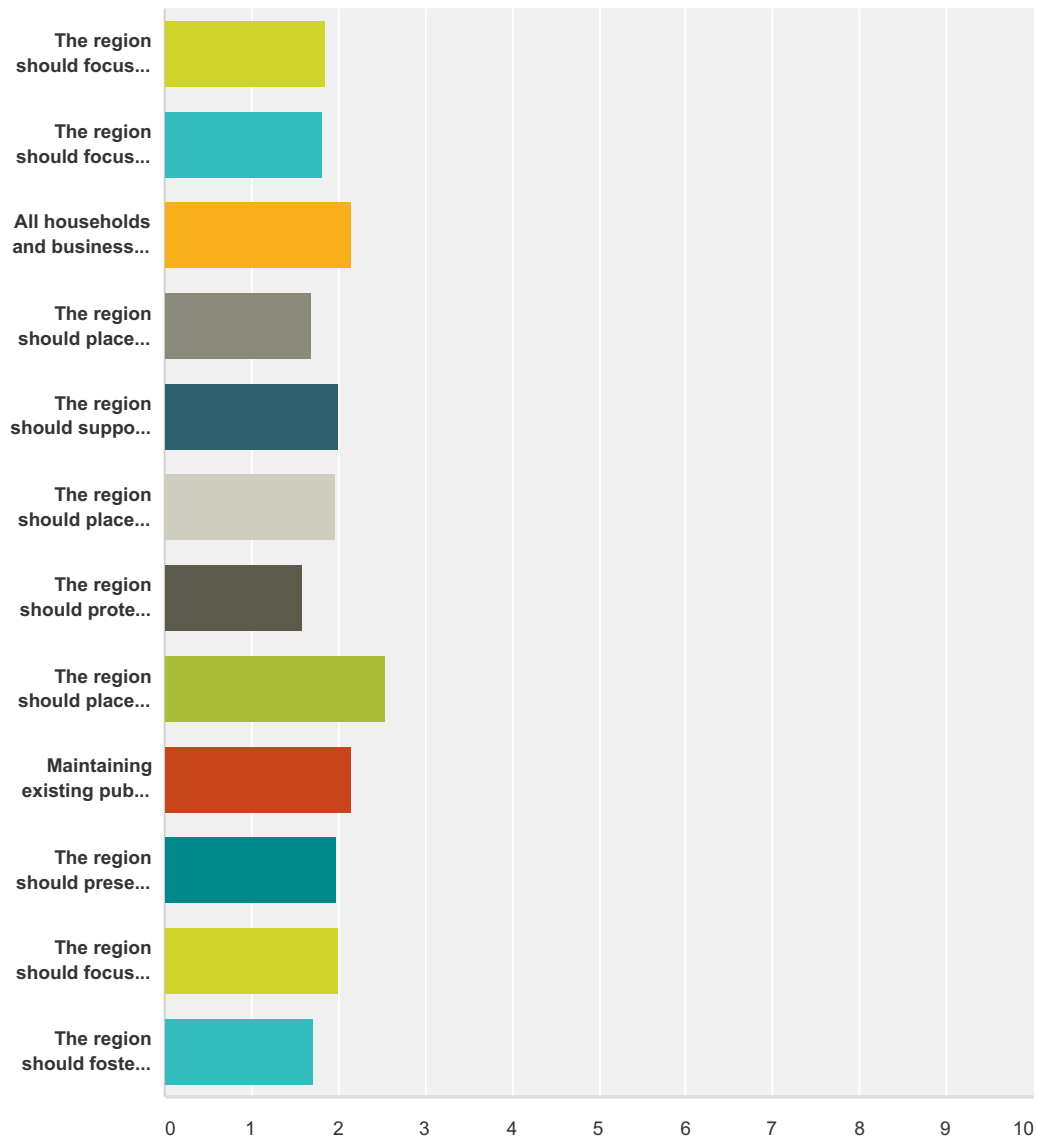

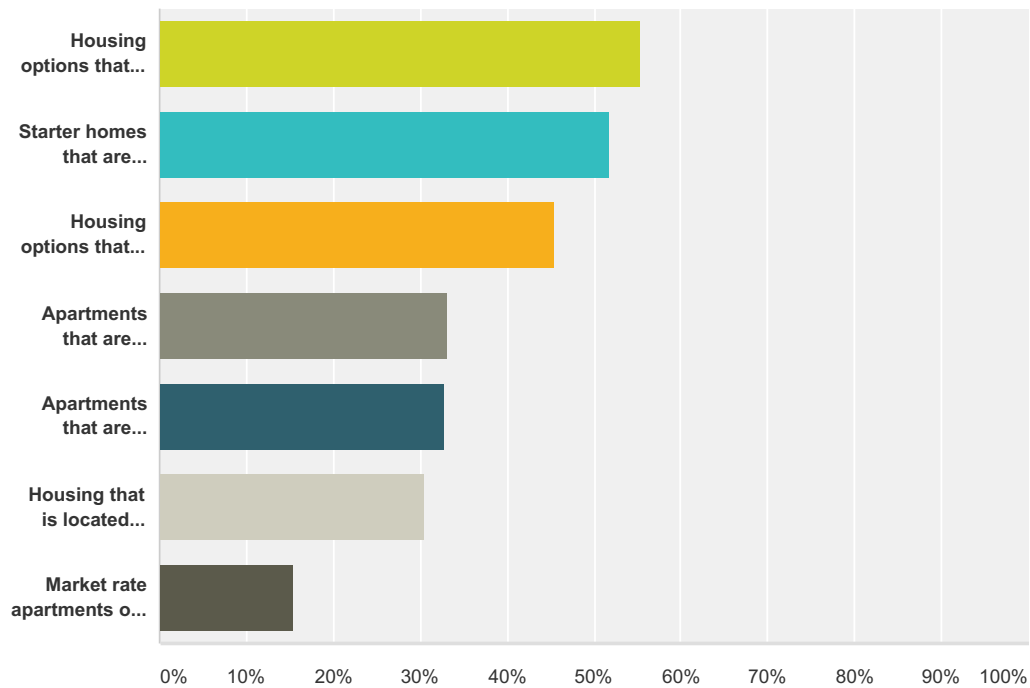

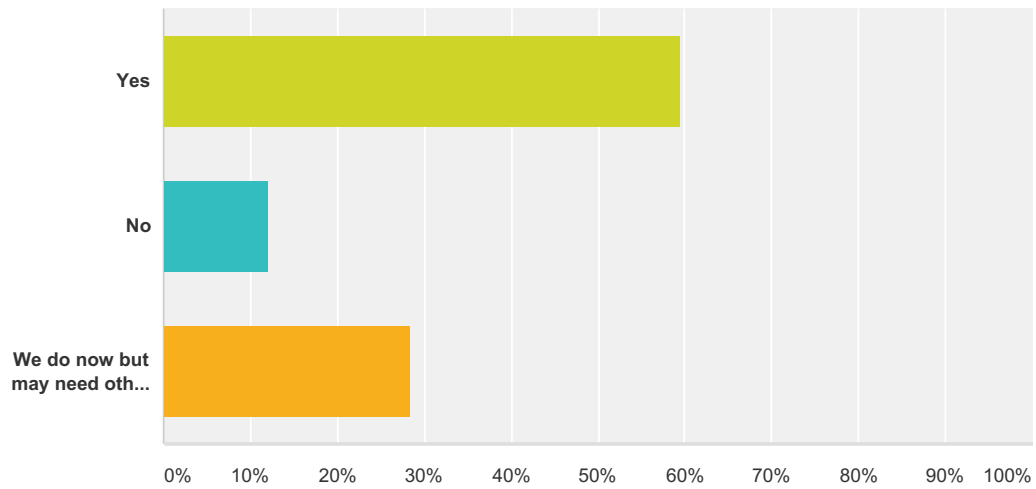

Q7 Do you and your family members have the housing options you need in your town?

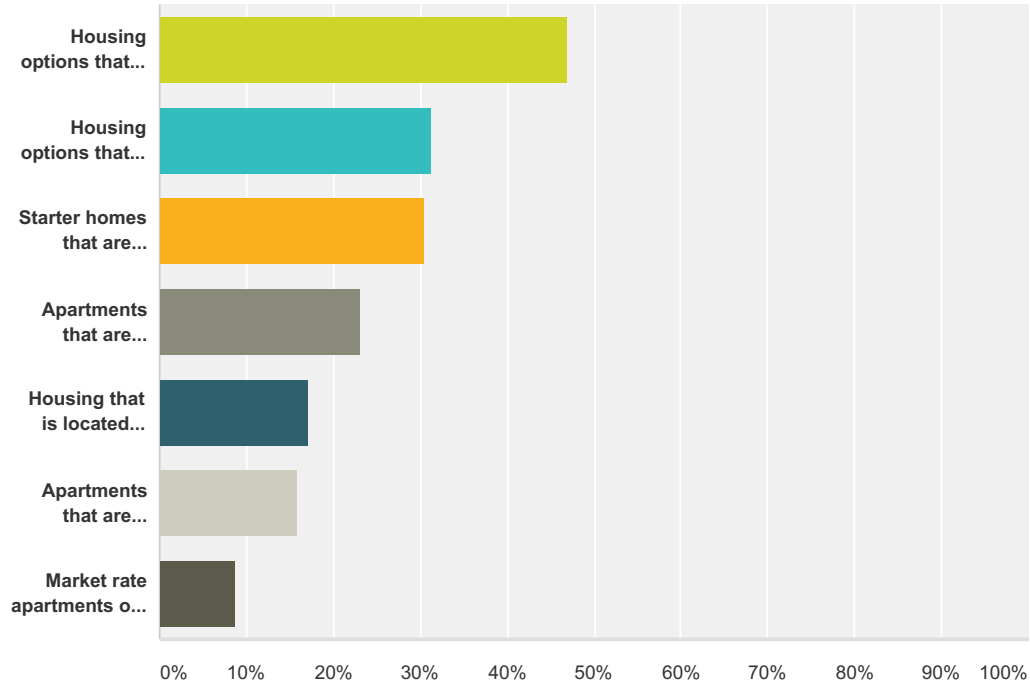

Q8 If no, which housing options are needed for you and your family? (Check all that apply)

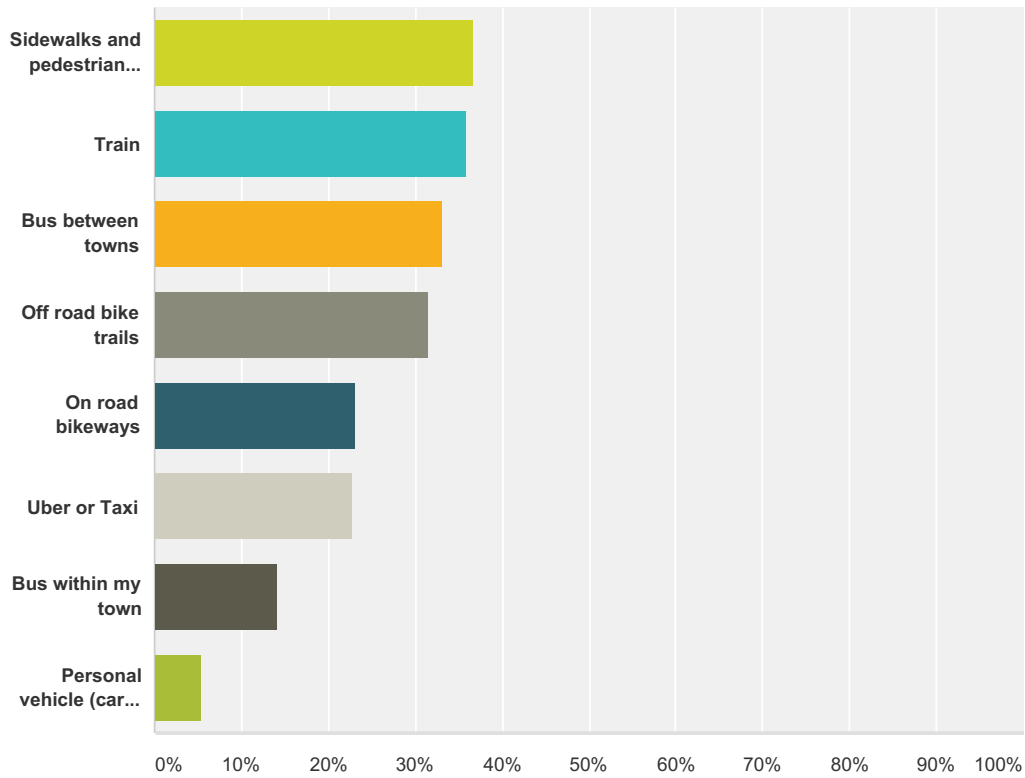

Q9 What types of transportation options would you like to use that you cannot access now or have very limited access to?

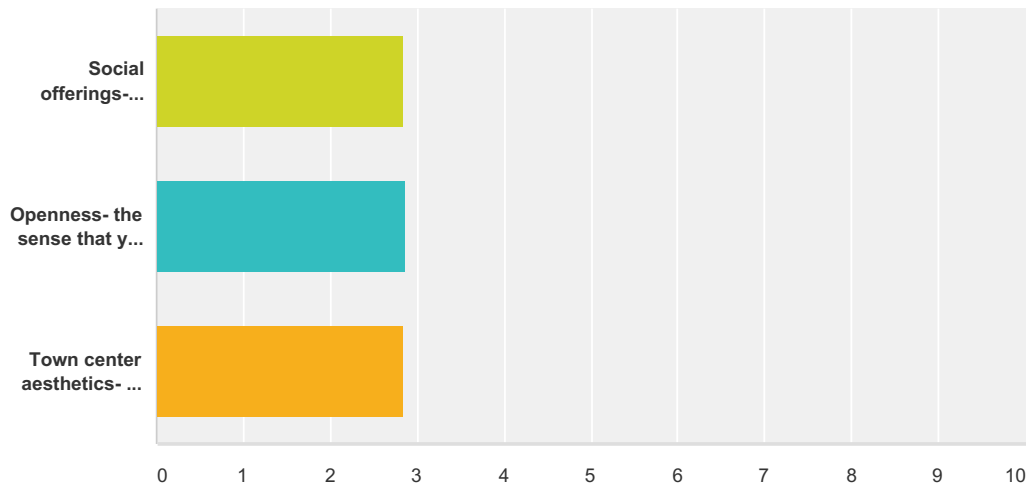

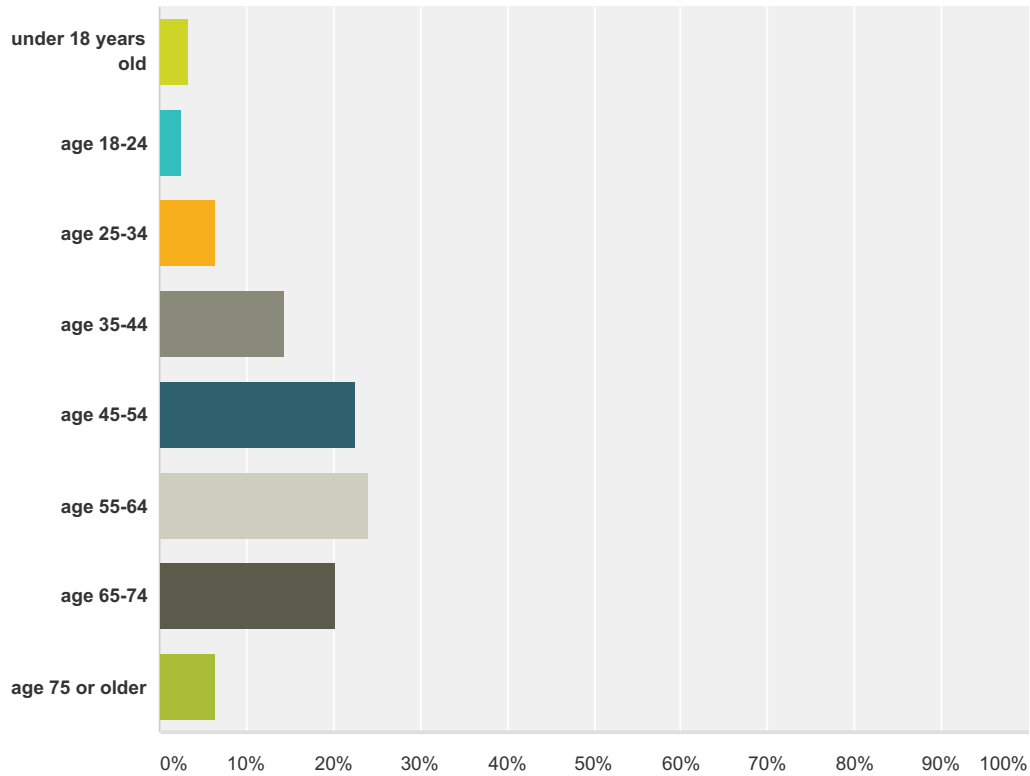
