


Housatonic River Overlay Zone (HROZ)

NOTES:

1) The factors determining the bounding lines of the Inner & Outer Corridors remain unchanged and are depicted as originally adopted.

Definitions of these lines are as follows:

- The Outer Corridor is the portion of the immediate river watershed lying between the Inner Corridor and the top of the river valley ridge, delineated by lines drawn from peak to peak along ridge lines.

- The Inner Corridor consists of the river steambelt and the FEMA 100 year flood hazard area, whichever is greater.

2) The Inner Corridor is revised to follow the updated boundary line as depicted & shown in the 2006 Housatonic River Management Plan.

3) This map was created by Northwest Conservation District and is intended for general planning purposes only. This document shall not be used as a subsitute for on-the-ground field verification.
