

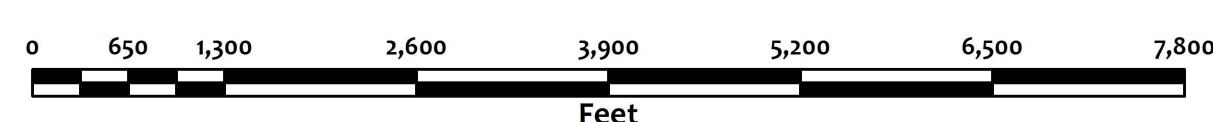

NOTES:

- 1) The factors determining the bounding lines of the Inner A Outer Corridors remain unchanged and are depicted as originally adopted. Definitions of these lines are as follows:
 - The Outer Corridor is the portion of the immediate river watershed lying between the Inner Corridor and the top of the river valley floor, delineated by the line from peak to peak along a given ridge.
 - The Inner Corridor consists of the river streambed and the FEMA 100 year flood hazard area, as well as any adjacent flood plain.
- 2) The Inner Corridor is revised to follow the updated boundary line as depicted & shown in the 2006 Houston River Management Plan.
- 3) This map was created by Northwest Conservation District and is intended for general planning purposes only. This document shall not be used as a substitute for on-the-ground field verification.
