- Encourage larger local employers to invest in workforce housing solutions such as providing on-site homebuyer education classes, down payment assistance and in some cases, rental assistance or new housing development.
- Work with local zoning commissions to provide them with "zoning best practices" that promote compact mixed use (housing and commercial) village/town centers.
